

It's hard for me to see how some writers still don't understand that just throwing some creepy elements into a story doesn't necessarily make it a successful one. Many of the endings are just blah, but I'll point out some that are great. "Snow" depicts a viral apocalypse that has something even more horrible behind it. The ending was masterful. "All the Day You'll Have Good Luck" tells a tale of a strange girl who is part of a strange family. The standout, "Fabulous Beasts" is a story so sensual, creepy and over-the-top you won't believe it, and if you are afraid of snakes, you make have to take a pill before you read it.
