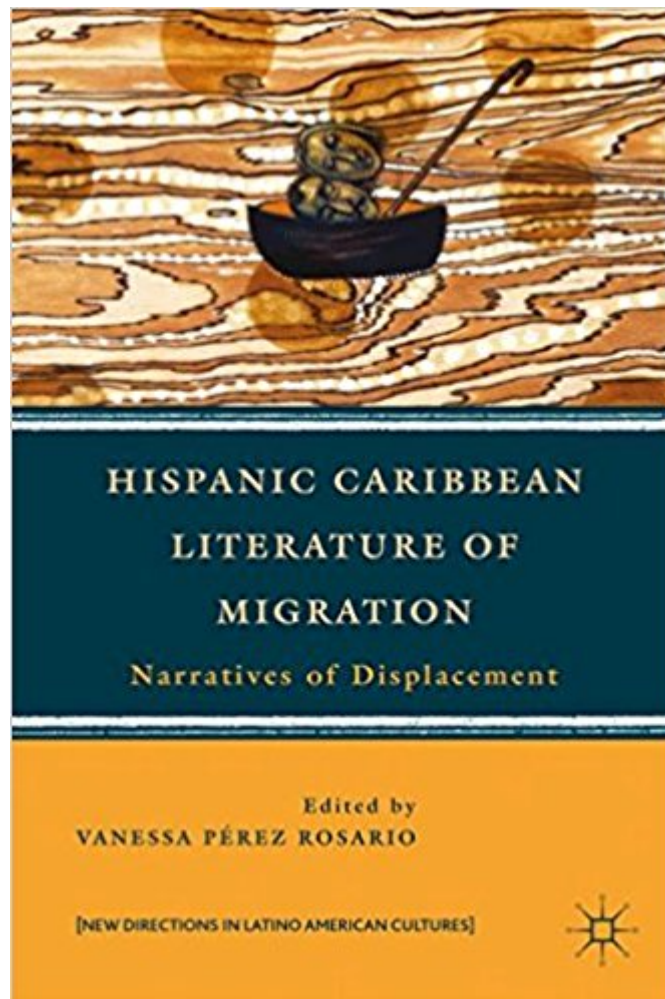


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Hispanic Caribbean Literature Of Migration: Narratives Of Displacement (New Directions In Latino American Cultures)
